URGENT! PRODUCT RECALL NOTICE FOR UNDECLARED ALLERGEN

*This recall is on all product produced between January 1, 2009 and February 16, 2010.

The recall includes these items only. These products are not to be consumed or served. Leahy/IFP requests that you immediately examine existing inventory, segregate and hold the above mentioned products. The above mentioned products are subject to a recall as they may contain undeclared wheat starch.

We have discovered that the subject products contain a potential allergen, specifically undeclared wheat. People who have an allergy or severe sensitivity to wheat run the risk of serious or life-threatening allergic reaction if they consume these products. For consumers who do not suffer from a wheat allergy or sensitivity, these products are safe to eat.

Customers who do not wish to use this product due to allergy or sensitivity concerns should destroy the product and contact their distributor representative for appropriate credit. You should keep the product container that identifies the product's manufacture code to verify that credit is due.

Please note that proper procedures must be followed and these cases may not be returned to your distributor.

If you have further distributed any of these products, then you are responsible to notify all consignees of this recall.
